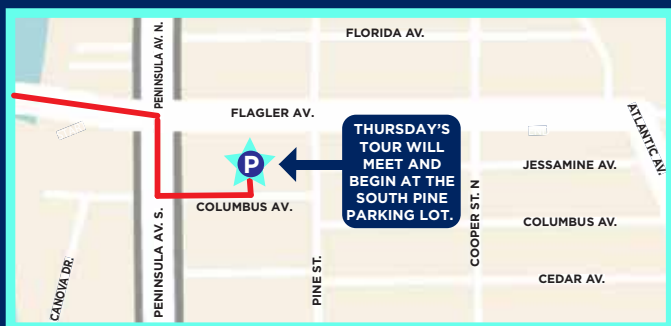


New Smyrna Museum of History



1. **Tuesday, The Three Downtowns of Old New Smyrna:** Explore multiple areas that started to become the town centers for New Smyrna, beginning with the Smyrnea' Settlement of 1768 through the arrival of Henry Flagler's Florida East Coast Railway.
2. **Wednesday, Central Historic District Tour:** Visit multiple local historic landmarks as well as sites where New Smyrna's first residents made their homes.
3. **Thursday, Old Coronado Beach & Flagler Avenue:** Discover a tomb in the middle of the street and a WWII watchtower site as you explore the story of the community formerly known as Coronado Beach. This tour meets in the South Pine Parking Lot south of Flagler Avenue. Please arrive 15 minutes early.
